INSTRUCTIONS

EXPLAIN TO THE STUDENTS THAT THEY ARE STUCK ON AN ISLAND. ASK THEM WHAT FIVE (YOU CAN USE A DIFFERENT NUMBER, SUCH AS SEVEN, DEPENDING UPON THE SIZE OF EACH TEAM) ITEMS THEY WOULD HAVE BROUGHT WITH THEM IF THEY KNEW THERE WAS A CHANCE THAT THEY MIGHT BE STRANDED. NOTE THAT STUDENTS ARE ONLY ALLOWED FIVE ITEMS PER TEAM, NOT PER PERSON. GET THE STUDENTS TO WRITE THEIR ITEMS ON A PIECE OF PAPER AND DISCUSS AND DEFEND THEIR CHOICES WITH THE WHOLE CLASS. GREAT FOR GENERATING CLASS DISCUSSION.
