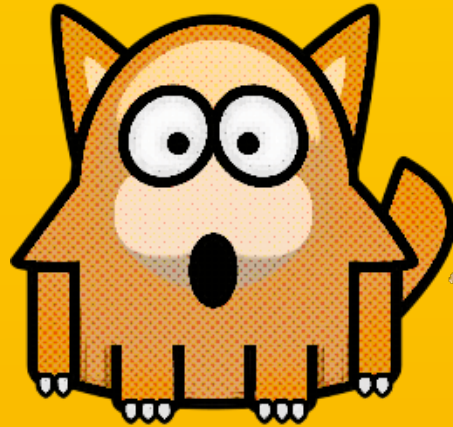


FOX, CHICKEN & GRAIN

INSTRUCTIONS

STUDENTS ARE GIVEN THE FOLLOWING PROBLEM, WHICH THEY NEED TO WORK TOWARDS A SOLUTION. THIS CAN BE PLAYED INSIDE OR OUTSIDE.

A FOX, A CHICKEN AND A SACK OF GRAIN ALL NEED TO GET ACROSS THE RIVER IN A SMALL BOAT. THE PROBLEM IS, THEY CANNOT ALL CROSS TOGETHER AS THE FOX WILL EAT THE CHICKEN IF PUT TOGETHER, AND THE CHICKEN WILL EAT THE GRAIN IF PUT TOGETHER.

GET THE CLASS TO WORK TOGETHER, OR SPLIT THEM INTO SMALL GROUPS. GIVE THEM TIME TO TALK AND WORK OUT THEIR PLAN BEFORE THEY ACTUALLY TRY AND CROSS THE RIVER. THIS GAME IS VERY GOOD FOR TEAMWORK AND PROBLEM SOLVING.
