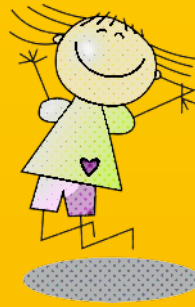
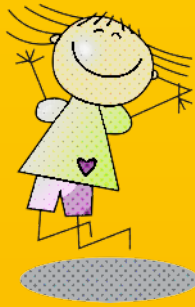


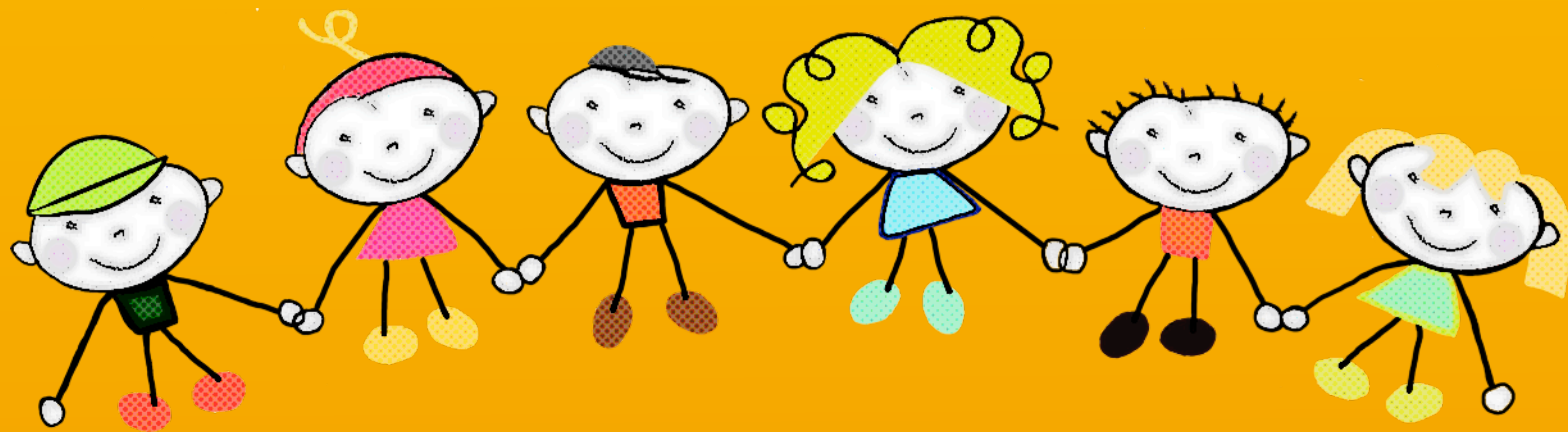
# SYLLABLE SYLLABLE

## INSTRUCTIONS

THE STUDENTS BEGIN BY FORMING A CIRCLE. THE FIRST STUDENT SAYS THEIR NAME, MAKING A GESTURE (AN ACTION) FOR EVERY SYLLABLE. FOR EXAMPLE, DAVID HAS TWO SYLLABLES, SO HE COULD CLAP HIS HANDS FOR 'DA' AND STAMP HIS FOOT FOR 'VID'. ALL THE STUDENTS REPEAT THIS, AND THEN THE SECOND STUDENT DOES THE SAME WITH HIS NAME, WITH A GESTURE PER SYLLABLE. THE STUDENTS REPEAT IT AND THEN REPEAT ALL THE PREVIOUS NAMES AND GESTURES FOR THE SYLLABLES. THIS IS A GREAT WARM-UP THAT ALSO HELPS A NEW GROUP LEARN EACH OTHER'S NAMES.
