

SNOWBALL TAG

TAG ACTIVITY

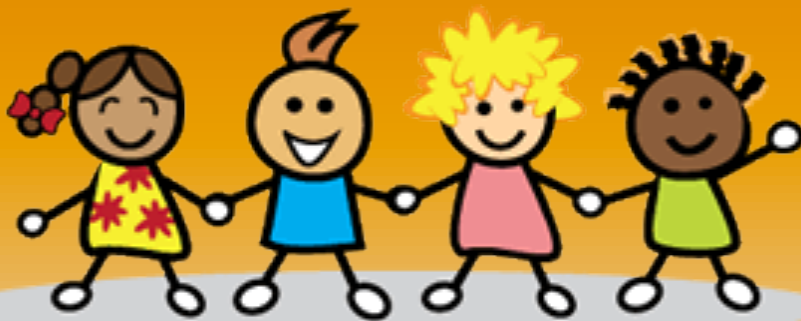


EQUIPMENT

ONE TENNIS BALL PER STUDENT AND FOUR CONES TO MARK A 10M X 10M SQUARE.

INSTRUCTIONS

THE STUDENTS ALL START THE GAME IN THE 10M X 10M SQUARE. THE TENNIS BALLS ARE PLACED TOGETHER ON THE EDGE OF THE SQUARE. THE TEACHER PICKS ONE STUDENT TO BE THE TAGGER, AND THEY START WITH ONE BALL. THE TAGGER THEN RUNS AROUND THE SQUARE TRYING TO TAG OTHER STUDENTS WITH THE BALL; THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO THROW THE BALL AND HAVE TO TAG STUDENTS BELOW SHOULDERS. ONCE A STUDENT HAS BEEN TAGGED THEY NEED TO PICK UP A BALL AND THEN THEY TRY AND TAG OTHER STUDENTS. THE LAST PLAYER LEFT IS THE WINNER. ONCE ALL STUDENTS HAVE BEEN TAGGED AND ARE HOLDING A BALL, THE ONLY STUDENT WHO DOES NOT HAVE A BALL BECOMES THE TAGGER. THIS STUDENT THEN TAGS STUDENTS WITH A BALL; WHEN STUDENTS ARE TAGGED THEY PLACE THE BALL BACK IN THE CORNER AND TRY AND TAG STUDENTS WITH A BALL. THE WINNER IS THE LAST STUDENT WITH A BALL.
